

# Immunizations

## OU Health Sciences Center

All students at the OU Health Sciences Center must be up-to-date on all required immunizations before being fully admitted to their degree program. See attached list.

If you are accepted into the College of Pharmacy, you should begin the process of completing your immunizations immediately. You must submit your completed immunization record to the Pharmacy Office of Student Affairs by June 1, 2011\*. Students who do not submit completed forms are at risk for having their admission offer rescinded and the loss of their admission deposit.

Proof of the required immunization is evidenced by either documentation of the date of the immunization or documentation of immunity by way of a titer (blood test). History of the illness does not indicate actual immunity and cannot be used to satisfy the requirement.

\*Hepatitis B: The Hepatitis B immunization is given in a series of 3 vaccinations. The second vaccination is given 1 month after the first. The third vaccination is given 6 months after the second. All students must have at least their second series completed by June 1, 2011 to meet the admission requirements.

The varicella (chickenpox) immunization is given in a two-part series with four to eight weeks between the two vaccines. This series must be complete by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

The cost of these immunizations/titers is the applicant's responsibility and is considered part of the requirement for admission.
