REFLECTIVE WRITING GUIDANCE:

What is reflective writing?

Reflective writing is:

- Your response to experiences, opinions, events, or new information
- Your response to thoughts and feelings
- A way of thinking to explore your learning
- An opportunity to gain self-knowledge and self-awareness
- A way to achieve clarity and better understanding of what you are learning
- A chance to develop and reinforce writing skills
- A way of making meaning out of what you learn

Reflective writing is NOT:

- Just conveying information, instruction, or argument
- Pure description, though there may be descriptive elements
- Straightforward decision or judgment (e.g. about whether something is right or wrong, good or bad)
- Simple problem-solving
- A standard essay

Steps of Reflection:

1. Content: What have I learned?
2. Process: How did I learn it?
3. Reasons: Why did I learn it?
4. Academic & Professional Development: How does this experience contribute to my academic and professional development?
5. Personal development: What does this experience mean to me personally?
