- Effective 09/01/2023
- **OAC 535:15-3-4(8)** : Physical requirements for pharmacies
- *Security: There shall be an electronic alarm and video recording system in place to provide protection against theft and diversion.*

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Pharmacy Security cont.

- **Recommendations:**
- Surveillance Camera(s) Placement
 - Points of entry including drive-thru window
 - Schedule II safe/cabinet
 - Cash register(s)
 - Exterior parking lot including drive-thru
- Motion Detectors
 - Lower level of placement (detect belly crawl)

Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Pharmacy Security cont.

- **Recommendations:**
- Vibration sensor on safe/locked cabinet
- Tracker bottles
- Create space between safe/locked cabinet and wall

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Report of Burglaries and Robberies

- Must notify **individually** OBNDD, DEA, and OSBP
- Notification must be in writing. Includes the initial notification to OSBP.
- Submit DEA 106 to all three agencies.
- Notify OSBP in writing within 1 (one) day of discovering the loss.
- Send copy of DEA 106 to OSBP within 14 days of filing the DEA 106.
- File police report if due to burglary and address point of entry to prevent future break-in.

Adequate Staffing Rules for Pharmacists and Pharmacies




- **OAC 535:15-3-16:** *Adequate staffing to safely fill prescriptions is the responsibility of the pharmacy, pharmacy manager, and the pharmacist.*
- In order to ensure adequate staffing levels, a staffing form shall be available in each pharmacy.
- Copy of the completed form will be given to the immediate supervisor and a copy must be available in the pharmacy for Board inspection.
- Each pharmacy shall review completed staffing reports and address any issues listed as well as document any corrective actions taken.

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Adequate Staffing Rules for Pharmacists and Pharmacies cont.




- Effective 09/01/2023
- **OAC 535:15-3-16(g)** : *An employing pharmacy shall not retaliate against or discipline an employee for filing a complaint with the Board of Pharmacy or other licensing body or reporting a suspected violation of state or federal statute.*



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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Adequate Staffing Rules for Pharmacists and Pharmacies cont.

- *Discipline of an employee includes, but is not limited to:*
 - *Removing or suspending the employee.*
 - *Withholding the employee salary increases or benefits to which the employee is otherwise entitled.*
 - *Transferring or reassigning the employee.*
 - *Denying the employee, a promotion that otherwise would have been received.*
 - *Reducing the employee pay or position.*

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Compounding Veterinarian Preparations

- Effective 09/01/2023
- **OAC 535:15-10-13(e)** : *It is acceptable for any licensed pharmacy to compound animal drugs from bulk substances for office use without patient-specific prescriptions for nonfood-producing animals if:*
 - *Drug is compounded by or under the direct supervision of a pharmacist in a state-licensed pharmacy or a federal facility.*
 - *Drug is intended for use in a nonfood-producing species and is compounded from a bulk drug substance listed on the FDA's "List of Bulk Drug Substances for Compounding Office Stock Drugs for Use in Nonfood-Producing Animals."*

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy

Compounding Veterinarian Preparations cont.

- Must report to FDA within 15 business days of any adverse event or product defect.
- Labeling requirements (see OAC 535:15-10-13(5))
- Veterinarians may dispense OR transfer compounded medications to:
 - The owner or caretaker of animal patient
 - A veterinarian within the same practice

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Pharmacy Technician Immunizations



- Effective 09/01/2023
- **OAC 535:15-13-6-1** : *Technician rules for administering immunizations:*
- Must be permitted Oklahoma pharmacy technician.
- One time registration and fee.
- Successfully completed an ACPE accredited immunization training program for technicians.
- Complete a minimum of 1 hour of immunization related ACPE accredited or Board approved Continuing Education (CE) annually.
- Maintain current CPR certification.

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Pharmacy Technician Immunizations cont.



- Pharmacist In Charge and pharmacy technician are responsible for maintaining training and education documentation.
- Documentation must be readily available for inspection.
- Pharmacy technician authorized to administer immunizations may administer vaccines delegated by the pharmacist on duty if:
 - Vaccine is FDA approved.
 - Vaccine is ordered and administered according to the CDC/ACIP recommendations.
 - Delegating pharmacist is readily and immediately available to the immunizing technician.
 - Delegating pharmacist is registered with the Board as an immunizing pharmacist and is current on all other requirements of the Board.

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Pharmacy Technician Immunizations cont.



- Pharmacy Technician Immunization Permit:
 - Must apply and obtain immunization permit from the Board.
 - Must be displayed in the pharmacy where the pharmacy technician is performing immunizations.
 - Duplicate immunization permits can be requested by the Board for a fee.
 - Pharmacy technician seeking reinstatement of technician permit must complete 2 hours of immunization related ACPE CE to also reinstate a previously issued immunization permit.

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Pharmacy Technician Reinstatement




OKLAHOMA
Board of Pharmacy

- Effective 09/01/2023
- **OAC 535:15-13-15** : *Technician reinstatement requirements*
- Applicant who possess an Oklahoma technician permit that was cancelled at request or cancelled for failure to renew.
- Technician permit shall be cancelled 30 days after expiration.
- Revoked technician permit is not eligible for reinstatement without appearing before the Board and receiving permission to apply.
- Must complete a technician reinstatement application.

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Pharmacy Technician Reinstatement cont.



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Board of Pharmacy

- Complete Phase I and Phase II training again if technician permit has lapsed for longer than one year.
- Complete pharmacy technician Board exam.
- May complete a new immunization application if immunizing technician does not reinstate immunization permit at the time of reinstatement.

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Pharmacist Immunizations

- Effective 09/01/2023
- **OAC 535:10-11-3:** *D.Ph. Administered immunization, training, and CE requirements*
 - Must complete an approved ACPE Training course and received registration for immunizations with the Board prior to administering immunizations.
 - Must maintain ongoing competency through required training, including at a minimum current CPR and 1 hour of immunization related ACPE accredited continuing education annually.

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Pharmacist Immunizations cont.



- **OAC 535:10-7-10(i)**: A pharmacist applicant who had an immunization permit must submit verification of 2 hours of immunization related ACPE CE with their pharmacist reinstatement application to also reinstate their immunization permit.
- May complete a new immunization application if immunizing pharmacist does not reinstate immunization permit at the time of reinstatement.

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Pharmacist Administering Immunization



Title 59, Chapter 8, Section 353.30(C):

*A pharmacist who has completed a requisite course of training as approved by the Board in consultation with the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision and the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners may administer therapeutic injections on orders from a licensed prescriber, and may administer immunizations that have been approved or authorized by the Food and Drug Administration without a patient-specific prescription, standing order or similar arrangement**

*Does not allow pharmacist to administer epinephrine or any other prescription drug for an anaphylactic reaction (need protocol in collaboration with a physician in place).

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Transfer of Prescriptions

- Effective 09/01/2023
- **OAC 535:15-3-12: Transfer of prescription refill information**
- CDS prescription transfers must be communicated directly between two licensed pharmacists and cannot be done by an intern.
- Transfers must be communicated orally directly between two licensed pharmacists and/or licensed interns (licensed intern if non-CDS).
- Prescription transfer information may be faxed from one pharmacy to another.
- Both original and the transferred prescription drug order must be maintained for a period of five years from the date of last refill.

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Shared Services

- ***OAC 535:15-3-2.1: Shared Services***
- *Data entry*
- *Interpreting the prescription or drug order*
- *Performing data entry verification*
- *Drug utilization review*
- *When necessary therapeutic intervention*
- *Shared services, after completion, includes returning the processed order to the requesting pharmacy for order filling, final order verification, and delivery to the patient or patient's care-giver.*

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Shared Services cont.



- Pharmacy must have a residential retail pharmacy license with the Board.
- Pharmacies involved in shared services must be located in Oklahoma.
- Same owner, or have a written contract or agreement that outlines the services provided and the shared responsibilities of each party in complying with federal and state pharmacy statutes and rules.
- Share a common electronic file or technology that allows access to information necessary or required to perform shared services.

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Shared Services cont.



- Licensed retail pharmacy engaged in shared services shall maintain manual or electronic records that:
 - Identify, individually for each order processed, the name, initials, or identification code of each pharmacist, intern, and pharmacy technician who took part in the data entry, order interpretation, data entry verification, drug utilization review, final order verification, and when necessary therapeutic intervention performed at that pharmacy.

- Provide adequate security to protect the confidentiality and integrity of patient information.
- Provide access for inspection of any required record or information of any request by the Board.

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy CDS Annual Inventory



- Completed annually between May 1st-June 30th
- Must include:
 - Outdated CDS in the pharmacy pending submission to reverse distributor
 - Bulk CDS utilized in compounding
 - PSE
 - CDS in crash carts
 - All CDS stored in auxiliary locations within the hospital
- Retain original or copy in pharmacy.
- Must be readily available for Board inspection.
- Submit original or copy with annual pharmacy licensure renewal.

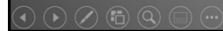

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy DEA 222 Forms Cont.

- Single-sheet form
- Purchaser issues the DEA 222 Form to the Supplier.
- Purchaser makes a copy of the DEA 222 Form prior sending original to the Supplier.
- Supplier completes their portion of the form and emails a copy of the complete form to DEA. Supplier keeps original form on file.
- Purchaser needs to complete the form (copy of the original) upon receipt of the drugs.
- Drug Suppliers:

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Durable Medical Equipment (DME)

- Effective 11/01/2022
- In accordance with HB 2649 creating the “Oklahoma Durable Medical Equipment Licensing Act.”
- **OAC 535:20-10-3(a)** : *Before conducting interstate and/or intrastate transactions in Oklahoma, a Durable Medical Equipment supplier (DME) or a combined DME Supplier and Medical Gas Distributor (DME + MGD) shall register annually with the Board.*

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Durable Medical Equipment (DME) cont.



OKLAHOMA
Board of Pharmacy

- **Oklahoma Durable Medical Equipment Licensing Act shall NOT apply to:**
 - Pharmacies and pharmacists
 - Hospitals
 - Ambulatory surgical centers
 - Health care facilities owned or operated by the state or federal government; ENR. H. B. NO. 2649 Page 6
 - Skilled nursing facilities
 - Assisted living facilities
 - Prosthetic or orthotic practitioners

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Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Durable Medical Equipment (DME) cont.




OKLAHOMA
Board of Pharmacy

- **Oklahoma Durable Medical Equipment Licensing Act shall NOT apply to:**
 - Health care practitioners who are licensed to practice health care in this state and who provide durable medical equipment within the scope of their health care practice.
 - Manufacturers or wholesale distributors that do not sell or rent durable medical equipment directly to consumers
 - Suppliers of insulin infusion pumps and related supplies or services
 - Suppliers of medical devices approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration that are used in the treatment of cancerous tumors
 - Disposable DME Suppliers if solely providing disposable DME such as catheters or ostomy supplies

Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Durable Medical Equipment (DME) cont.

- **OAC 535:20-10-2:** *“Durable Medical Equipment” or “DME” means equipment for which a prescription is required, including repair and replacement parts, and that:*
 - (A) *can stand repeated use*
 - (B) *has an expected useful life at least three (3) YEARS*
 - (C) *is primarily and customarily used to serve a medical purpose*
 - (D) *is not generally useful to a person in the absence of illness or injury*
 - (E) *is appropriate for use in the home, and*
 - (F) *is intended for use by the consumer*

Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Durable Medical Equipment (DME) cont.

- **OAC 535:20-10-2(G):** *Durable medical equipment includes, but is not limited to:*
 - *Ambulating assistance equipment*
 - *Mobility equipment*
 - *Rehabilitation seating*
 - *Oxygen care and oxygen delivery systems*
 - *Respiratory equipment and respiratory disease management devices*
 - *Rehabilitation environmental control equipment*
 - *Ventilators*
 - *Apnea monitors*
 - *Diagnostic equipment*
 - *Feeding pumps*
 - *Beds prescribed by physicians to alleviate medical conditions*
 - *Transcutaneous electrical nerve stimulators*
 - *Sequential compression devices*

- Effective 11/01/2023
- Preparation of compounded drug products for over-the-counter sale.
- **Title 59 O.S. 353.1c: Practice of Pharmacy**
- *A pharmacist licensed by the State Board of Pharmacy may, in accordance with state and federal laws and rules, prescribe nonprescription drugs for the purposes of extemporaneous compounding or compounding for a known patient need in the practice area. The Board may promulgate rules to implement this section.*

OAC 535:15-6-17 Board of Pharmacy Inspections

(b) Any discrepancies or deficiencies noted at inspection shall be corrected

- Not a recommendation (expectation)
- Prompt resolution
- Warning Notice/Case before Board may result
- Reach out to Board staff as a resource to maintain compliance

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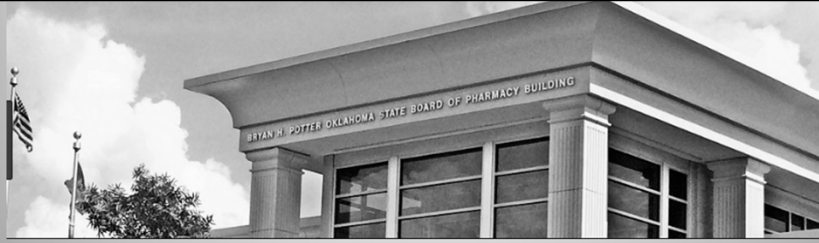
