The PGY2 Critical Care residency with OU Health/OU College of Pharmacy is a one year specialty residency program in which the resident will gain extensive experience in critical care pharmacotherapy, pharmacokinetics and interacting in an interdisciplinary environment.

Rotation Structure

Core Rotations: Required

- Orientation concentrated experience, up to one month
- Emergency Medicine one month rotation (fall)
- Medical Intensive Care Unit one month rotation
- Medical Intensive Care Unit Student Precepting one month rotation (spring)
- Trauma Intensive Care Unit one month rotation
- Neurological Intensive Care Unit one month rotation
- Surgical Intensive Care Unit/ECMO Service one month rotation
- Research one month rotation

<u>Elective Rotations Options</u>: Four one month rotations from below:

- Advanced experience in any of the required clinical core rotations (separate learning experiences to be adapted based on resident's goals & interests)
- Cardiac Emergencies/Intensive Care
- Clinical Toxicology (Oklahoma Center for Poison & Drug Information)
- Infectious Diseases for Critical Care
- Neonatal Intensive Care Unit
- Pediatric Intensive Care Unit
